

**Energisa Group's consumption captive and free energy consumption rises 3.5% in May 2017
Accumulated consumption rises by 1.6% in the first five months of 2017.**

Consumption in May 2017: Energisa Group's captive and free electricity consumption (2,443.3 GWh) rose 3.5% in May 2017 over the same month last year. If uninvoiced sales are included, the volume changes to 2,413.3 GWh, an increase of 1.4%. Partly because of consumers migrating from the captive sector, the free market (TUSD) experienced consumption growth of 29.9%. Captive consumption (2,044.3 GWh) contracted 0.5% in the month, impacted by said migrations.

Captive plus free energy consumption in May was strong in the Midwest region of Brazil. Energisa Mato Grosso achieved its highest ever sales, experiencing growth of 7.1% in the month. This result was influenced by the longer billing month and higher temperatures than in 2016, which drove consumption by the residential (+13.5%) and commercial (+7.1%) sectors. The rural class rose by 6.9%, driven by the record soybean harvest. The industrial segment did not follow the other sectors in said region, growing by just 0.4%, influenced by lower energy consumption by producers of cement and food products.

Energy sales by Energisa Borborema were also strong in the month, with consumption rising 6.6%, and an average increase of 3.4% in sales by the distribution companies located in the South/Southeast region, with all distribution companies experiencing consumption growth in relation to the same month the previous year.

Consumption remains strong at the distribution companies: Bragantina (+6.5%) and CFLO (+4.8%). Energisa Sergipe, however, experienced a consumption contraction of 1.5% in May, partly due to the heavy rainfall in the state and lower consumption by two major free clients.

Sales in the first five months of 2017: Energisa Group's captive and free electricity consumption (12,269.4 GWh) rose in the first five months of 2017 by 1.6% over the same period last year. If uninvoiced sales are included, the volume changes to 12,250.6 GWh, an increase of 1.7%. Partly because of consumers migrating from the captive sector, the free market (TUSD) experienced consumption growth of 31.9%. Captive consumption (10,362.6 GWh) contracted slightly by 2.5% in May, due to the aforesaid migrations.

Captive plus free energy consumption was strong in the North-East region of Brazil in the first five months of 2017, increasing by an average 2.6% at the Group's distribution companies, driven by the sales of Energisa Borborema (+7.0%). There was also strong consumption in the period at Bragantina (+5.0%) and Energisa Mato Grosso do Sul in the Midwest, experiencing an increase of 1.7% over the same period the previous year.
