

Captive and free consumption at Energisa Group accumulates an increase of 1.2% in the 1st four months

Sales in the 1st four months of 2017: Energisa Group's captive and free electricity consumption (9,826.0 GWh) rose in the 1st four months of 2017 by 1.2% over the same period last year. If uninvoiced sales are included, the volume changes to 9,837.2 GWh, an increase of 1.8% over the same period of 2016. Partly because of consumers migrating from the captive sector, the free market (TUSD) experienced consumption growth of 32.4%. Captive consumption (8,318.3 GWh) contracted by 3.0% in the first four months of 2017, due to the aforesaid migrations.

Captive plus free energy consumption in the four-month period was strong in the North-East region of Brazil, with increases at the distribution companies Energisa Borborema (+7.1%) and Energisa Paraíba (+3.7%), driven by the recount of public lighting points in these concessions. There was also strong consumption in the midwest in the period, with Energisa Mato Grosso do Sul experiencing an increase of 2.3% over the same four-month period the previous year. The highest consumption increases were again recorded in the South/Southeast Region by the distribution companies: Bragantina (+4.7%), CFLO (+1.9%) and CNEE (+1.3%).

Energy sales in April 2017: suffering from the effects of cooler temperatures, heavier rainfall and fewer invoicing

days, Energisa Group's energy sales contracted by 1.9% in April.

We emphasize that the level of consumption in April 2016 was high due to the El Niño weather phenomenon, which caused an increase in temperatures in the concession areas of the distribution companies located in the North and Midwest. The shorter invoicing month was due to the negative impact caused by there being more long-weekend holidays in April compared with the previous year. If we disregard the atypical consumption in the fourth month of 2016, energy consumption in April 2017 exceeded consumption in the last eight years. Consolidated residential and commercial consumption (free and captive) contracted by 2.4% in the month, except in the areas of the distribution companies located in the North-East region of Brazil, which saw consumption rise: Energisa Sergipe (residential: +5.2% and commercial: +0.8%), Energisa Borborema (residential: +2.5% and commercial: +0.8%) and Energisa Paraíba (residential: +1.3% and commercial: +1.5%).
